Subject: NH Campgrounds Deemed Essential Businesses

Hello campground owners and managers,

We hope this finds you well. We wanted to send you the following information.

There has been conflicting messages about whether or not campgrounds in NH are essential businesses allowed to operate during the COVID-19 pandemic. Last week we asked for clarification of campground's status. The following was published today.

The clarification clearly states that campgrounds are considered essential "only for the purposes of providing parcels of land rented for the placement of a tent or recreational vehicles."

Please note that while campgrounds are designated as essential, they are urged to follow social distancing protocols in accordance with guidance from the Department of Public Health, including but not limited to:

1. Prohibiting all gatherings with more than 10 individuals
2. Keeping all personnel six feet apart
3. Encouraging employees to stay home when sick, and sending home those who report feeling ill or display symptoms
