



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON
PERMIT APPLICATION FOR A
SOLID WASTE LANDFILL**

**MT. CARBERRY SECURE LANDFILL

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (NHDES) has received a Type I-A Permit Modification Application, pursuant to RSA 149-M:9, from Androscoggin Valley Regional Refuse Disposal District (AVRRDD), 3 Twelfth Street, PO Box 336, Berlin, NH 03570, to vertically expand the Mt. Carberry Secure Landfill by adding Stage 12 on top of the existing Phases 1 and 2. Proposed Stage 12 would add about 710,000 cubic yards of capacity on top of the existing landfill to extend the facility's life expectancy by about 2.3 years to 2025. An expansion of the landfill footprint is not proposed.

Pursuant to RSA 149-M:9 and Solid Waste Administrative Rule Env-Sw 304.08, a public hearing to receive testimony on this permit application will be held at the Berlin City Hall Auditorium, 168 Main Street, Berlin, NH on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 at 6 PM. The permit application is available for public review during regular business hours at the AVRRDD Office, 3 Twelfth Street, Berlin, NH and at the NHDES' office at 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH. Testimony may be submitted in writing to NHDES at any time before close of the public hearing period, which is May 15, 2018 at 4:00 pm, in lieu of attending and/or providing oral testimony at the public hearing. Comments sent to other addresses will not be included in the public record.
