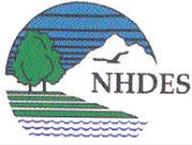

## **Public Meeting Notice**

### **NHDES and US Army Corps of Engineers to Host Public Meeting Regarding the Proposed Reissuance Of The Department of the Army New Hampshire Programmatic General Permit**

*Public Meeting to be held April 11*

Concord, NH – The Department of Environmental Services (DES) and the US Army Corps of Engineers will hold a joint public meeting/information session on the Corps' proposed changes to the State Wetlands Programmatic General Permit (PGP) on April 11, 2007. The meeting will be held at 1:00 at the DES auditorium at 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH. On Monday, April 2, 2007, the Corps is expected to issue a Public Notice for this meeting. The Public Notice with a summary of the proposed changes can be found on-line at the **New England District US Army Corps of Engineers website: <http://www.nae.usace.army.mil/reg>**

The New England District, US Army Corps of Engineers, 696 Virginia Road, Concord MA hereby proposes to reissue the PGP, pursuant to 33 CFR Part 325.5(c)(3) for minimal impact activities within the State of New Hampshire. The existing PGP will expire on June 2, 2007 and the Corps proposes to reissue the PGP for another five years no later than this date. The reissued PGP will continue the expedited review process for activities in Corps jurisdiction under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 and Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act. This public notice is issued in accordance with 33 CFR 325.3(b) to coordinate reissuance of the PGP with Federal resource agencies, state agencies and the public.
