Deadline for NHPPP Governor's Award is fast approaching

Concord, NH – The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services Pollution Prevention Program Governor's Award application deadline is fast approaching. The deadline is June 6th and the judging will commence the following week. The award winners will be notified during Pollution Prevention Week after a complete compliance investigation has been conducted.

The Governor's Award for Pollution Prevention recognizes businesses and other organizations for their outstanding pollution prevention accomplishments. Award recipients will be recognized for specific programs that go beyond regulatory requirements to reduce or eliminate the generation of waste. Qualified applicants must be in compliance with state and federal environmental laws, and their pollution prevention efforts must be voluntary.

Winners will receive a hand-cut New Hampshire granite trophy, and public recognition in press releases and trade papers.
