DES Workshop on the Comprehensive Shoreland Protection Act

Workshop Monday, August 11, 2008

Concord, NH – The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services will conduct a workshop Monday, August 11, 2008, on the amended Comprehensive Shoreland Protection Act (CSPA) that becomes effective July 1, 2008. The workshop will provide an opportunity for people living and working along our lakes and rivers to learn about the CSPA. Details regarding the workshop are provided below:

WHAT: Workshop on the amended CSPA that becomes effective July 1, 2008.

WHEN: Monday, August 11, 2008; 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

WHERE: Church Landing, the Inns at Mills Falls, Meredith, N.H.

COST: \$30 per person includes breakfast, beverages, attendance at the sessions; does *not* include lunch.
