Re: General State Permit for Source Category: Internal Combustion Engines - Emergency Generators or Fire Pump Engines

To Whom It May Concern:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (NHDES) is hereby notifying you that the expiration date of the General State Permit for Source Category: Internal Combustion Engines – Emergency Generators or Fire Pump Engines (GSP) issued to your facility and previously scheduled to expire on **April 30, 2020** has been extended for 3 months in accordance with the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Env-A 610, *General State Permits and General Permits under Title V*. The new expiration date for the General State Permit is **July 31, 2020**. In accordance with Env-A 610.13, *Expiration Date and General State Permit Reestablishment Procedures*, a public notice of extension of the expiration date of the GSP was prepared by NHDES and published in the *Union Leader* on April 10, 2020.

NHDES chose to extend the expiration date to allow for additional time prior to issuing the re-established GSP during the state of emergency in New Hampshire due to COVID-19. **No action to re-register under the GSP is required of facilities at this time. NHDES will notify you in writing when the new GSP is re-established.**
