

Hazardous Waste Rules: Readoption with Amendments

Env-Hw 100 – 1200 adopted to be effective August 14, 2017

State-Initiated Revisions

Revisions for clarity (throughout)

Env-Hw 100

- Updated the edition dates of federal regulations cited in the rules (Env-Hw 101.04)
- Moved text of statutory and federal definitions to appendices (Env-Hw 103, 104)
- Adopted definitions for *containment building*, *drip pad*, *explosives or munitions emergency*, explosives or munitions emergency response, explosives or munitions emergency response specialist, household, household hazardous waste, land disposal, military munitions, and state-only waste (Env-Hw 103, 104)
- Removed unneeded definitions for council, electrochemical cell, hazardous waste storage area, integral design, New Hampshire identification number, subsequent notification form, and universal waste transfer facility (Env-Hw 103, 104)
- Changed certification to professional certification and DOT to USDOT (Env-Hw 103, 104)

Env-Hw 200

Added requirements for certifications required throughout the rules (Env-Hw 207)

Env-Hw 300

- Added an exemption for responding to explosives or munitions emergencies (Env-Hw 303.02)
- Clarified permit application requirements (Env-Hw 304)

Env-Hw 400

- Clarified applicability of the rules to hazardous waste mixtures (Env-Hw 401.01, 404.01)
- Moved text of definitions either to Env-Hw 401.02 or to appendix (Env-Hw 401.03)
- Adopted HW exemptions related to newly adopted HW listings (Env-Hw 401.03)
- Repealed pharmaceutical waste exemption (Env-Hw 401.03(b)(26)) in response to 2016 HB 1490, which revised the definition of hazardous waste in RSA 147-A:2, VII
- Clarified documentation requirements for HW exemptions (Env-Hw 401.03)
- Adopted HW listings (Env-Hw 402.04 402.07)
- Clarified F006 listing (Env-Hw 402.06)
- Repealed outdated HW listings (Env-Hw 402.05, 402.07)

- Adopted an exemption for responding to explosives or munitions emergencies (Env-Hw 501.02)
- Added definitions for central accumulation area and satellite accumulation area (Env-Hw 501.03)
- Clarified requirements for documenting HW determinations (Env-Hw 502.01)
- Clarified generator classification requirements (Env-Hw 503.02, 503.03)
- Clarified notification requirements (Env-Hw 504)
- Added provisions to inactivate/reactivate EPA identification numbers and requirements for declassification to be requested in writing (Env-Hw 505)
- Reorganized and clarified generator "accumulation" (formerly "storage") requirements (Env-Hw 507 - 509) [Inspection recordkeeping requirements for SQG extended storage and FQG satellite storage were proposed but were not adopted]
- Added provisions for use of drip pads and containment buildings by FQGs (Env-Hw 509.02)
- Adopted federal Land Disposal Restrictions (Env-Hw 509.05)
- Updated and clarified manifest requirements (Env-Hw 510)
- Updated import/export provisions (Env-Hw 510.06, 512.03)
- Added provisions for a generator to submit manifest copies if the designated facility fails to do so (Env-Hw 511.01)
- Updated recordkeeping requirements (Env-Hw 512.01, 512.02)
- Added provisions for responding to releases prior to cleanup plan approval (Env-Hw 513.02)
- Updated SQG self-certification requirements (Env-Hw 514)

- Adopted federal military munitions transportation requirements and an exemption for responding to explosives or munitions emergencies (Env-Hw 601.01, 601.02)
- Clarified notification requirements (Env-Hw 602)
- Reorganized transporter requirements (Env-Hw 603)
- Updated import/export provisions (Env-Hw 604)
- Added provisions for responding to releases prior to cleanup plan approval (Env-Hw 608.02)

- Adopted exemption for responding to explosives or munitions emergencies (Env-Hw 701.02)
- Clarified exemption for solid waste facilities managing non-hazardous solid waste (Env-Hw 701.02)
