<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>KEENE PUBLIC LIBRARY</u></b>  <b>(603) 352-0157</b>  <b>60 Winter Street</b>  <b>Keene, NH</b>  <b>- KAY FOX ROOM -</b></p>	<p><b>For map and directions from the library web site:</b> <a href="http://www.keenepubliclibrary.org/library/location">www.keenepubliclibrary.org/library/location</a>  <b>From the South or East:</b> Go north on Main St. and proceed around the square at the head of Main St., Winter St., and Court St. both branch off from the square, with Court St. going north and Winter St. (a one-way street) going west. The red stone Court House building is on the corner. The Library is on the left between National Grange Mutual and the Library annex, formerly the Masonic Hall. <b>From the North:</b> Go down Washington St., proceed around the square and exit at Winter St. Or, go down Court St. and turn right onto Winter St. just before the square. The Library will be on your left. <b>From the West:</b> Go down West St. until you get to the traffic light at School St. Turn left onto School St., go north for 2 blocks, turn right onto Summer St., then right onto Middle St., then right onto Winter St. The Library will be on your left.</p>

Get off at Exit 5, Rt 111 East (Kinsley St). Take Rt 111 East to the fourth set of lights and turn left on Main St. Follow Main St north and at the third set of lights turn right on Temple St. Take Temple St to the second left onto Cottage Ave and into the City's metered parking lot (spaces without meters are privately owned, and unauthorized cars parked in them may be towed). The library is at the northwest corner of the lot. <b>From the North:</b> Take the Everett Turnpike (Rt 3) South. Take Exit 7-E, Rt 101-A (Amherst St). Take Rt 101-A to the major intersection and turn right onto Main St. Follow Main St. south and at the third set of lights turn left onto Temple St. Take Temple St. to the second left onto Cottage Ave. and into the City's metered parking lot (spaces without meters are privately owned, and unauthorized cars parked in them may be towed). The library is at the northwest corner of the lot.</p>

At third light (at top of hill) turn left onto Hazen Drive. Turn left at sign for Health &amp; Human Services. <b>From the North:</b> Take I-93 south to Exit 15E onto I-393. Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp (onto East Side Drive). Stay to the right and turn right at light onto Hazen Drive. Turn right at sign for Health &amp; Human Services. <b>From the East:</b> Take Rte 4 west to Concord (Rte 4 becomes I-393 in Concord). Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp. Stay to the right and turn right at second light onto Hazen Drive. Turn right at sign for Health &amp; Human Services.</p>
