



Notice to Auto Salvage Yard Operators about completing the  
New "Junk Vehicle End-of-Life Form"

December 17, 2009

The recently revised (Sept. 2009) Junk Vehicle End-of-Life Form #TDMV 13A (see copy on the backside of this notice), which you must complete for each vehicle that you crush, shred, bale or shear in this state, asks you to provide your "DES Motor Vehicle Salvage Facility Permit Number" in Section 3. However, the NH Department of Environmental Services (DES) has not yet developed the applicable permit registration process and the rules for obtaining a permit number. Therefore, you should leave this line blank until further notice.

When the permit rules and the permit registration forms become available, we will send you the form and instructions for obtaining a permit and permit number. We will also contact you during the actual permit development process, to give you the opportunity to comment on the proposed rules and permitting procedures before they are finalized.
