In accordance with RSA 482:79, notice is hereby given that the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Water Division, will hold a public hearing related to an investigation of levels of inland waters at Mendums Pond in Barrington, NH at 10:00 AM on June 16, 2018. The hearing will be held at the Barrington Middle School, Barrington, NH.

Beginning at 10:00 AM June 16, 2018, the Department will receive testimony from the public concerning a request for a Lake Level Investigation focused primarily on winter drawdown levels at Mendums Pond. The current winter drawdown is 7 feet below the normal summer lake level.

Testimony may be presented orally and/or in writing at the public hearing. The Department also will receive written comments on the proposed rules until 4:00 PM on Friday, July 13, 2018. Please submit written comments to:
