Please consider these comments and suggestions regarding proposed rule, Env-Wt 103.23 “*Major Docking Structure*”:

We suggest amending Env-Wt 103.23 (b) by changing “700 square feet” to “900 square feet”.

Consider that Env-Wt 103.23 (c) mentions 5 or more boatslips and that a “standard” 4 boatslip seasonal “W” shaped dock will be approximately 864 square feet (three finger piers at 6 ft x 40 ft and two 12 ft x 6 ft connecting walkways).

Therefore, for the sake of consistency within this rule, the trigger for “*Major Docking Structure*” should be more congruent among the criteria and 900 square feet is a more reasonable surface area impact for a 5 boatslip structure.
