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Please consider these comments and suggestions regarding proposed rule, Env-Wt 104.47 *“Wave Attenuator”*:

We suggest replacing the proposed language of Env-Wt 104.47 as follows:

*“Wave Attenuator” means a seasonal or permanent structure specifically designed to dampen wave action that is not considered a “Breakwater” under Env-Wt 102.21.*

A wave attenuator is designed to break-up wave lengths to dampen wave action and protect structure(s) or property, however, there are numerous designs and types of these structures and both seasonal and permanent alternatives exist. These types of structures are not “Breakwaters” involving fill on the bottom.
