Processed Shredder Residue for use as Alternate Daily Cover**

Dear Keri Fitzpatrick:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (NHDES) has completed its review of the above-referenced application submitted by Prolerized New England Company, LLC (Prolerized) seeking certification of a waste-derived product made during metal shredding operations at its Everett, MA facility. Specifically, Prolerized requested certification of Processed Shredder Residue for use as alternate daily cover at authorized double-lined landfills.

NHDES has approved the application, with conditions, and hereby issues the attached certified waste-derived product (CWDP) No. 31 pursuant to RSA 149-M:9 and Chapter Env-Sw 1500 of the NH Solid Waste Rules, Env-Sw 100 et seq. (Rules).

Any person aggrieved by this decision can file an appeal with the NH Waste Management Council (Council). Any such appeal must be filed directly with the Council in accordance with the Council's rules, [Env-WMC 204, Appeals: Filing; Notice; Parties and Representatives; Scheduling; Motions](#). The appeal must be filed **directly with the Council within 30 days** of the date of this decision and must set forth fully **every ground** upon which it is claimed that the decision complained of is unlawful or unreasonable. Only those grounds set forth in the notice of appeal can be considered by the Council. Information about the Council, including a link to the Council's rules, is available on their [website](#).
