



Solid Waste Facility Continuity of Operations Planning

NHDES recognizes that the services provided by solid waste facilities and haulers are essential services as stated in the [Governor's Emergency Order #17](#) and [#17A](#), and that solid waste operations must continue during this time. To ensure communication with permitted solid waste facilities, the NHDES Solid Waste Management Bureau will be reaching out in the coming weeks to those listed as the contact person at each permitted solid waste facility as outlined below. A map of these assignments and districts is enclosed in this notice. Please share this information as applicable with employees, contractors, and affected parties.

Collection/Storage/Transfer Facilities

In order to facilitate communication with the large number of solid waste transfer facilities in New Hampshire, NHDES has divided the state into 6 Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) Districts. Transfer facilities within each COOP District have an assigned contact person in the Solid Waste Management Bureau.

Landfills and Processing & Treatment Facilities

A contact person in the Solid Waste Management Bureau has also been assigned for these facility types. Those landfills and processing/treatment facilities with collection/storage/transfer facilities on the same site will only have a single NHDES contact assigned.

As a reminder, the NHDES Solid Waste Management Bureau has compiled a [list of resources](#) that discuss handling of solid waste with potential or known COVID-19 contamination. Please check the linked websites in the list frequently as knowledge and best management practices are rapidly evolving.

If your facility needs to make changes to operations in order to meet the recommended guidance, including changes to:

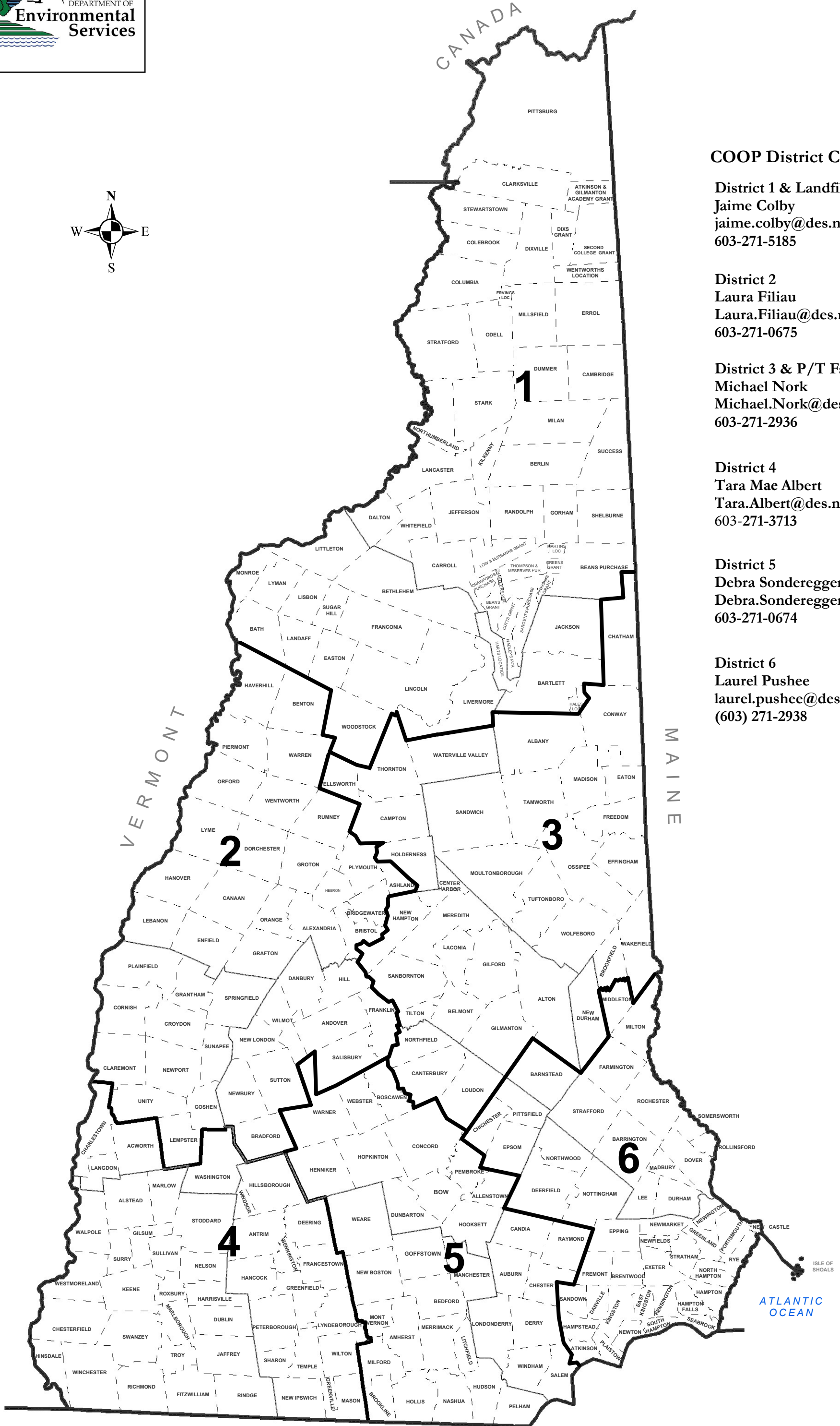
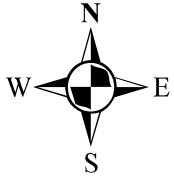
- Minimize contact with solid waste that has potential or known COVID-19 contamination;
